

SWIMMING SAFETY RULES AND HOUSE RULES

Swimming should be above all fun. Nevertheless, the swimming pool safety rules should be read and observed carefully, as there is always a certain amount of safety risk near the water.

Swimming Safety

- Children under the age of 7 must be accompanied in the water by a competent adult swimmer.
- The competent adult swimmer must actively supervise the children under the age of 7.
- A maximum of 3 inexperienced swimmers are allowed per 1 adult of 18 years or older.
- Children who do not have a swimming certificate are required to wear inflatable armbands, everywhere in the accommodation and outside on the field.
- For safety no admittance for adults that do not know how to swim in the pool.
- Visitors must be able to understand staff for safety reasons. If you don't speak basic English, German or Dutch an accompanying translator must be present near you.
- Do not enter the water if you feel unwell or have other medical conditions.
- Make sure the water is clear and deep enough before jumping in.
- Be considerate in the swimming pool, as space in the public pool is limited, mutual respect plays an important role.

Admittence

- All visitors must be able to show a valid ID if asked upon.
- Always follow the instructions of the staff.
- Appropriate swimwear is required for going into the pool area.
- Long swimshorts (below or on the knee) are forbidden.
- Underwear is no swimwear.
- A swimshort with metal zippers or other metal parts means no admittance to the tube slides.
- Shower shortly before swimming.
- No smoking, vaping or any kind of other drugs. Inside and outside.
- You are only allowed to enter the pool area if you are barefoot or wearing slippers
- Make sure that the water and its surroundings remain clean. Waste goes in the rubbish bin.
- Running is not permitted in the pool area.
- Glassware is not permitted in the pool area and outside on the field.
- Use the lockers to store bags and other personal items.
- It is strictly forbidden to take photos and/or videos anywhere without permission of the staff. Violating this rule can result in being denied admission to the swimming pool.
- It is forbidden to bring alcohol or be under the influence of drugs/alcohol.

General

- For your safety and for the safety of staff, there is video surveillance
- Verbal abuse and/or physical violence will not be tolerated.
- Intimacy of any kind, whether desired or undesired, will not be tolerated.
- You may not be in the changing area without a valid reason.
- Management is not liable for any loss, damage and/or theft of your property.
- Management is not liable for bodily injury in and around the buildings.
- The police will always be notified in the event of a criminal offence. Breaking these house rules can result in being barred from the swimming pools.
- Instructions by the staff are valid above other house rules. Failure to follow instructions means you will have to leave.

Opening hours

- The opening hours can be found on <u>www.twentebad.nl</u>
- The opening hours always depend on the crowds en the weather conditions.
- The management reserves the right to change the opening hours when needed, without refund of entrance fees
- When guests are informed the swimming pool is closing, you must be dressed and leave the accommodation within 15 minutes.
